Code of Conduct for Umpires

- 1. Umpires shall wear the proper attire depending on the tournament requirements.
- 2. Umpires shall not engage directly or indirectly in any conduct that is prejudicial to the game of cricket.
- 3. Umpires shall at all times adhere to the By-Laws of the WCL.
- 4. Umpires must be at the game by at latest 30 minutes prior to the start.
- 5. Umpires shall not excessively fraternize with players during the course of the game.
- 6. All communications between the umpires and players during the course of the game must be in English.
- 7. Umpires shall not engage in any verbal or physical altercations with players.
- 8. Umpires shall not accept bribes or engage in betting on any WCL game.
- 9. Umpires shall not be a party to contriving or attempting to contrive the result of any WCL match.
- 10. Umpires shall not receive any money, benefits or other rewards, whether financial or otherwise that is prejudicial to the game of cricket and could bring him or the WCL into disrepute.
- 11. Umpires shall not in any manner taunt, insult, use contemptuous words, make sarcastic comments, make biting remarks, provoke or issue a challenge to any player.
- 12. Umpires shall at all times conduct themselves in an ethical and professional manner.
