
How to submit a scorecard on WCL website

- 1. Visit the WCL website <u>www.wclinc.com</u>.
- 2. Under the Matches tab, click on Results.



3. Select the appropriate 'Series', 'Division', and 'Team'.



4. Under 'Admin Actions' click on 'Full Scorecard'. <u>You need to be a 'Team Scorer'</u> or a 'Team Admin' in order to see the 'Admin Actions' option. Please email EC at <u>WCLEC@WCLINC.COM</u> if you need these privileges.



5. Enter the scorecard manually in the spreadsheet. A complete scorecard needs to be entered for **BOTH innings,_including players that DID NOT BAT.** For the batting statistics to show up in the list of highest scores, highest run scorer, etc., the number of balls faced by the batsman must be entered as well.

- If you did online scoring for your game, you do not need to enter the scorecard manually. Teams must still ensure that the scorecard visible on the website is accurate.
- 7. If you did online scoring for only one innings, the second innings scorecard needs to be entered manually.
- 8. As per the by-laws, it is the responsibility of the **home team** to ensure that complete scorecard for **both innings** are submitted on the website.
- 9. As per the by-laws, \$100 fine will be imposed if complete scorecards are not submitted by midnight Tuesday, after the game has been played.
